- Item 4 - I do hereby appoint H B Bradford and C H Bradford Executors of this my last will and testament.

Item 5:-

I give and bequeath to each of my three children, Wm. Ella Bailey, Kate & John Thomas Wallis, the sum of \$1000.00 in full and final settlement of all claims, debts and demands of any kind, and I so direct that any indebtedness that may be owing by any of my children by any of said heirs be settled out of this division.

Item 6:-

I give and bequeath to my daughter Ella Bailey, and my son Walter Wallis, each in and to them jointly (\$2000.00) Callers each in addition to the largest in item five, in full and final settlement of all claims, debts and demands of any kind, and I so direct that any indebtedness that may be owing by any of my children by any of said heirs be settled out of this division.

Item 7:-

I my brother C. C. Wallis be in life when this my last will and testament takes effect and has no means of support, it is my will and I so direct that my executor take in and pay, set aside for his support and maintenance, One Thousand (\$1000.00) Callers, if there be any other my special bequests herein made by me, to be paid over to him in installments of fifty (\$50.00) Callers every three months until the One Thousand (\$1000.00) Callers is expended. If the said One Thousand (\$1000.00) Callers is expended and the said C. C. Wallis has no insurance at his death, I desire and direct that as much as Two Thousand (\$2000.00) of earnings expended on his burial expenses, and a mass for his poor. The residue of same at his death shall revert to my estate, and be disposed of as provided in Item Eight of this my last will and testament.

Item 8:-

I give and bequeath to each of my three children, Wm. Ella Bailey, Kate & John Thomas Wallis, the sum of \$1000.00 in full and final settlement of all claims, debts and demands of any kind, and I so direct that any indebtedness that may be owing by any of my children by any of said heirs be settled out of this division.

Item 9:-

It is my will that if it be shown that the provisions made above are not sufficient to provide for my daughter Ella Bailey on account of her sickness or disabled condition and she has no other means of support, she may by making a satisfactory showing to the Court or probate judge of the State and County of her residence, the Court may order such an amount of the property or bonds sold, and the proceeds applied to her support while she may be in such need, only enough of the principal is to be used as is necessary to relieve such needs. If my daughter Ella Bailey is without any money or other property when the bequest made to her in Item Eighth of this my last will, it is my will and I so direct that my Executors draw from the said bonds or other property left covered by this will the following to wit: To defray funeral expenses, and
