

It is my will and I do direct that my husband Marababu Samma Wood have the management and the income from my estate during his life or as long as he remains single for the use of himself and my son Francis Samma Wood.

In the event of the death of my husband M. Samma Wood, or in the event of his remarriage to another woman then it is my will, that my son Francis L Wood have the management of the income from my estate during his life how ever should he in the meantime accumulate and make good and stable investments above all indebtedness the sum of Five Thousand (\$5000) dollars then I direct that he have my entire estate in fee simple.

If my son Francis L Wood should die before he acquires my estate in fee simple as above set forth leaving a wife with whom he was living at the time of his death then I direct that she receive the net income from my estate for a living for herself and child or children by my son Francis L Wood, and for an education for the child or children if there be any during her life or as long as she remains the widow of my son Francis L Wood or until the youngest child reaches the age of Twenty One (21) years.

If my son Francis L Wood's wife ceases to be a beneficiary of this my will as above set forth by death, remarriage to another, or by the youngest child becoming Twenty One (21) years old, then I direct that my estate both real and personal vest in my son Francis L Wood's child or children his bodily heirs if he has any living share and share alike.

It my will that in the event that this my will has served all the purposes above set forth and my son Francis L Wood has no bodily heirs living I then direct that my property of all kinds both real and personal be sold and the proceeds invested in United States Bonds and the interest from same be used as a loan at 4% per annum to poor deserving boys and girls to help them secure an education. Same to be paid

be as easy as they can do after they are through school without working a hardship on them. I then give that the money and interest be turned to others of the same churchmenational above significantly.

It is my will that under no circumstances shall my estate be subject to any debt contracted by any one until it is acquired in fee simple under the provisions of this my last will and testament.

It is my will and I so direct that my son Francis C Wood after he takes over the management of my estate that he pay over the Congregational Church, Springfield, \$1000 a year in memory of Mrs Jane Riley a former member of said church my mother and his Grandmother payment of same to cease at the death of my son Francis C Wood. I hereby substitute and appoint E. C. and Linn Lesh's Wagon and L. O. Eric as executors to this my last will and testament, and I request my executor or either one of them that in the most easy of access to look after my son Francis and advise with him and direct him in the management of his business and that he are rendering this service to paid a reasonable amount from the income of my estate for same.
