 Walter F. Wallace the sole executor of this my
 last will and testament, and I expressly
 confer upon him power as such, to Admin-
 ister my estate, expending him from
 giving any bond, or making any return
 to the Ordinary, and I expressly confer
 upon him the full authority and power
 to sell any part of my estate that he
 may deem necessary to make an equitable
 distribution thereof, at public or private
 sale with or without notice, and without
 and without any order of Court, making
 good and sufficient conveyances to the purchaser
 and holding the proceeds of the said sale to the
 same uses and divisions as directed in
 item three of this my last will and
 testament.
