Item (1) I will that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner, subject to my executors and administrators in life.

Item (2) I will that my just debts be paid as soon as practicable after my death.

Item (3) I will that after my death the heirs of my one half acre of land, being my home place where I now reside, to wit, and the proceeds to be divided as follows: That Lillis Presley, Nellie Presley, Bessie to have fifty (\$50) Dollars each of the proceeds; then Loris Presley & Nelson Presley, my be heirs to be divided equally among all share & share alike.

Item 4 I will and direct that Lillis Presley have the sewing machine and dresser, the balance of the household & kitchen furniture and personal belongings to be divided equally between Lillis Presley, Nellie Presley and Nellie Presley, as is best suited to each.

Item 5 I do hereby appoint Robert A. Farley as Executor of this my last will and testament, and release him of all claims bond to the County.

Item 1 Intending this to be my last will and I hereby revoke all wills heretofore made by me.

Item 2 I will and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner, subject to my executors and administrators in life, and the expenses paid for out of my estate.

Item 3 I desire and direct that my executors or administrators, after my death, pay all my just debts, out of my perishable or personal property if necessary to make a call to all claims at public or private sale.

Item 4 I give and bequeath to my wife, Elizabeth B. Stephenson, all my real and personal property of every kind, for and during her natural life or widowhood, and compelling her to give benefit and support of her and minor children.

Item 5 I desire and direct that my wife maintain and educate my children up to the age of 18 years, equal with time preceeding them, and pay the same out of my estate.

Item 6 I will if my said widow should intermarry that she have a child out of my estate which estate shall fall into hands of my executors for sale, said executors to be Testamentary Guardians for all of my children under 18 years of age, and to pay bonds for same, and to pay over to such children their private share of my estate when they arrive at 18 years of age, and be relieved from the guardianship.

Item 7 I will and direct that my wife or Executors shall give to each heir the sum herein mentioned, or hereafter mentioned, which shall precede the Executors division and does not include tax, hog, or breeding. Said sum being three hundred and fifty dollars advanced in money.

- Item 8 It is my will that at the death of my wife or hereafter said that my estate shall be equally divided share and share alike between my children as per item 7 of this my last will.
- Item 9 I give to my person herein named as a legatee shall hereinafter be set aside whatever direct or indirect claims of the same this will, or to the same or her shall the legacy will be made not take part in and vest in the legatee who may in R. Stephenson effort.
- Item 10 I do hereby appoint to this my last will and in the case of the death of either of the executors named that the two then living shall execute this will and hereto in testimony whereof I have set my hand this February 15-1908 (L.B.) Josiah J. Stephenson
