last will and testament, hereby appearing and
enrolling all others by me to be fore made.

- Item 1 I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christianlike manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition
in life.
- Item 2 I desire and direct that my just debts
be paid without unnecessary delay by my
executor hereinafter named and appointed.
- Item 3 I desire and direct that my executor
hereinafter named and appointed, erect
a Monument at my grave of the same
design and pattern as the one at my Mother's
grave, my monument to have on
graving on one side thereof the Insignia or
working tools of the Order of the
and accepted Masons, and on the other side
the Insignia or Working Tools of the Blue Lodge
of said Masonic Order, together with such
inscription as my executor may deem
fit and proper with the date of my
birth (to wit) August 26th 1862 and that
It is further my will and desire
that one half (1/2) acre of land, the site of
cemetery where my mother is buried,
and where I will be interred, be forever
reserved and set aside as said cemetery
together with a road 20 feet wide from
said cemetery to the public Road.
- Item 4 I desire and direct that my Executor
hereinafter named and appointed, have
the graves of my self and Mother cleaned
off once per year.
- Item 5 I give bequeath and devise to C. R. Vaughan
the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, this
gift being in appreciation of
services rendered.

and as a token of friendship to the
 I have signed and given to Mrs C. R. Vanebo
 my old book containing a list of the names of
 persons together with an old cash account
 on which I have this day being made
 up in accordance of and as a reminder
 of the friendship existing between myself
 and her father and grand father.

Item 7

Since while we were living together as husband and wife, I have made over to my
 former wife Mrs Vanebo, all such
 money and other things of value as I owned
 and since in addition to such valuable
 she has been divorced, and I have felt
 her such sums as required of me as a
 for herself and child travels, it is therefore
 my will and desire that neither the said
 Grace Vanebo Barker, nor her daughter
 Francis, nor any other of her child or children
 shall further in my estate or receive any
 thing under this my last will and tes-
 tament.

Item 8

Under the payment of debts and special
 requests as herein set forth, I give, bequeath
 and devise all of the residue of my estate to
 my sons said Paul Emory Barker and
 Jost Sherman Barker said Emory Barker
 being in better health and more capable of
 forming a lively head than my son Jost
 Sherman Barker shall receive one fourth
 (1/4) of said residue to be paid to him without
 restriction or limitation. The remaining
 three fourths (3/4) of said residue is hereby given
 bequeathed and devised to my son Jost
 Sherman Barker, with the following conditions
 and limitations to wit: The said interest of
 Jost Sherman Barker shall go to and be held
 by my Executor herein after named and aft-
 erwards, his trustee for said son, he to disburse
 such sums or so much thereof as may be necessary
 for the caring of, providing for, and sustaining
 the said Jost Sherman Barker, to the end
 that he may be kept from becoming dependent

upon charity or State. Should I should
 not survive but be dead leaving part of
 said funds unexpended, such as remain
 in hands of my executor shall be by him
 divided amongst my heirs at law as
 they may be entitled.

Item 10

I hereby constitute, name and appoint
 Mr W. Smith, Executor of this my last will
 and testament, and I express my com-
 plete full power as such, to administer
 my estate, expending him from paying my
 debts, or making any return to the Ordinary
 and I expressly confer upon him the full
 authority and power to sell any part of my
 estate, not heretofore expressly devised
 at public or private sale with or without
 notice, as he may deem best, and without
 any order of Court, making good and suf-
 ficient conveyance to the purchaser, and
 holding the proceeds of the said sale to the
 same uses, and trusts, as heretofore
 declared in the several items of this my will.
 I further hereby expressly confer upon him
 the authority and power to borrow money
 for the use of said estate in any instance
 where he may think it necessary and
 proper, and to secure the same by lien or
 mortgage, security deed, or trust deed,
 or any form of security to or upon any
 part of my estate not heretofore spe-
 cially devised this he may also do without
 the order of any Court.

Item 11

Should Executor refuse to act, resign
 or not survive the Trust herein expressed, then
 and in that event, the Ordinary of said
 county shall make petition to the Judge of
 the Superior Court of said County praying
 the filling of said vacancy, whereupon the
 said Judge may by proper order and decree
 appoint some proper and discreet to act as
 Executor and trustee herein.
