I J. R. Ellington, of said State and county, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore by me made.

- Item 1 It is my will and desire that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner, suitable to my condition in life, the place and details of which I leave to my family.
- Item 2 It is my will and desire that my just debts be paid as soon as practical after my death.
- Item 3 I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved daughter Mrs. Maggie House for and during her natural life Sixty (60) acres of land off of the "Cane place" where I now reside known as the Lucas Place and at her death, with remainder over to her children, in equal parts, share and share alike. Said Sixty (60) acres to be cut off of both sides of the public landing by said place, and her portion is to include the same or dwelling.
- Item 4 I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved son, James L. Ellington, for and during his natural life, the remaining fifty one (51) acres of said "Cane place" known as the Lucas Place and forty nine (49 1/2) in said State and county, where he now resides known as the Echols Place with remainder over at his death to his children, in equal parts, share and share alike.
- Item 5 I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved son Pleas B. Ellington for and during his natural life Eighty three (83) acres of land in

to sell any part of my estate for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this my last will and testament, not herein specially designated as public or private, with or without order of Court, with or without notice as he may deem best. I further authorize and empower him to borrow money for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this my last will and testament or for the use of the said estate, and to execute releases or mortgages, and other arrangements or instruments, and do what is necessary for him to do to protect the same and to take charge for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this my last will and testament.
