Smith, to be theirs absolutely in fee simple
forever.
- Item (4) If either my said nephew or niece shall die
before this will takes effect, leaving no issue
then it is my will and desire that all of
my estate aforesaid shall go to the survivors
if either shall die before this my last will shall
take effect, leaving child or children, then it is
my will and desire that said child or children
shall inherit in lieu of its deceased parent.
- Item (5) If both of my said nephew & niece shall die
before this my last will and testament takes effect
then it is my will and desire that all of my
estate, both real and personal, go to my
beloved Sister Mrs Mary J Smith.
- Item (6) I hereby constitute and appoint my said
nephew P. B. Smith the sole executor of this my
last will and testament, and expressly confer
upon him, as such to administer my estate
excusing him from giving bond, or making any
returns to the Ordinary, and I expressly confer
upon him the full power and authority, to sell any and
all of my estate, at public or private sale
