

I have this willing, ready, sound and disposing mind and meaning to make this my last will and testament, being revoking any and all that I have heretofore made.

- Item 1 I do so my will, that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, suitable to my circumstances and condition in life.
- Item 2 I desire and direct that all of my just debts be paid without unnecessary delay by my executors hereafter named and appointed.
- Item 3 Should I leave in life at my death my husband, W. H. McElroy, I will, suggest and desire all of my property, both real and personal, of whatever kind and wherever situated, to be my husband, W. H. McElroy, to be his absolutely and in fee simple forever.
- Item 4 Should my husband be dead at my death, then I desire and direct that my property both real and personal be divided between my children share and share alike, with this condition, that should I from any cause in the last days or years of my life find it more comfortable or desirable to have my home with either of my children, it is my wish and I direct that that child or children have no fee any division of my estate a home equal to one thousand dollars for every child or children that such child or children may be put to by reason of my having lived with them.
- Item 5 I hereby make my husband, W. H. McElroy, executor of his will and I relieve him from making any inventory of my property or appraisement, or giving any bond, and he is required only by this will to probate the will, and he is further relieved from making any return of his assets and things to any court that may.
