

YOUNG RUSSIAN IS PROUD TO ANSWER CALL OF AMERICA

Nathan Minsk, of Atlanta, in
Letters to Parents, Delin-
eates Splendid Spirit Which
Animates American Troops

Nathan Minsk, son of Mr. and Mrs. S. Minsk, of 275 East Fair street, Russian-born, but educated in America, has answered the call of America for men, and two splendid letters to his parents express that American spirit of consecration and flaming patriotism which shall make the Germans wish they had never even dreamed of world conquest.

Declaring that Russia, the country of his birth, "has been, as all the world knows, dishonored and dishonestly dealt with," and that America is "fighting for the weak," young Minsk says that he "as a loyal son of this grand republic is ready to die that the ideals for which she stands should exist."

Mr. and Mrs. Minsk are both Russians. They came to Atlanta about fifteen years ago, and brought Nathan Minsk, who was born in Minsk, Russia, and who, at the time he came to Atlanta, was a little baby. He received his education in Atlanta schools, and is now in training at Fort Oglethorpe. The following letters are of interest because of the fine spirit shown:

Young Minsk's Letters

"Dear Mother, Father, Beloved Sister, Brothers and all My Friends: "I, like millions of brave America's sons, have answered the cry of my country for help.

"With the spirit of God, and the courage of Judas Maccabeus over me, I will rush 'over the top' for my country and Zionism.

"Dear ones, just imagine a hospital in England with the weak and wounded fighting for life, being bombarded. Only a man with a 'yellow streak' and no love for his God and humanity would not give his life to avenge such a dastardly and cowardly deed.

"Dear mother, father: Your training, my education, religious and otherwise, has taught me to be a man and trust in the Almighty seated on His throne in the celestial regions.

"The country of my birth, Russia, has been, as all the world knows, dishonored and dishonestly dealt with. The strong must protect the weak. America is fighting for the weak and I as a loyal son of this grand republic am ready to die, that the ideals for which she stands should exist.

"America's ideals will and must be spread avar the universe, and with the help of the Almighty, I will do my
