




Your letter relative to the Eastern Cherokee enrollment is at hand, and you are advised that your application has been given a preliminary examination but it has not yet been finally acted upon.



Fill Randl went to the Territory and get an allotment. He settled there and so id his children. I grandfither died after we left I.C. My father proved by three witnesses one that he was a Cherokoo Indian.
