

Died at the Kimball.

Mrs. N. B. Trist, nee Waring, died at the Kimball House at 11:30 o'clock last night. Deceased was the wife of Mr. N. B. Trist, a traveling man, with headquarters at Philadelphia. She was born and raised in Savannah, Ga., and was the daughter of W. W. Waring of that place. She had also a brother, Dr. J. J. Waring, in Savannah, and another brother, Dr. W. R. Waring, at Chester, S. C.

On the 16th of the present month Mrs. Trist went to the Kimball House, where room No. 617 was assigned her. Friday night she gave birth to a child. The child died and was sent to Savannah for interment in the Waring family's vault. During her illness a telegram was sent her husband, and at her death another was sent. An answer was received stating that he would start immediately. He is expected here to day, and her remains will probably be taken to Savannah.

Mrs. Trist was a most estimable lady and is descended from one of the finest and oldest families in Georgia.
