

## MR. HORSEY DEAD.

**His Son Finds Him Insensible in the Yard  
Last Night.**

Last night about 9 o'clock Mr. T. M. Horsey, an old and respected merchant of the city, was found in his front yard by his son in an insensible condition.

He was carried into the house and a physician sent for.

Notwithstanding all that was done for him, he never recovered consciousness, and died shortly afterwards.

The attending physician refused to grant a burial certificate, which necessitated the holding of an inquest.

Coroner Avary, with a jury, went to the residence to the right of Marietta street and after making an autopsy, found that Mr. Horsey's death was caused by apoplexy.

Mr. Horsey came to Atlanta from Charleston many years ago. The funeral arrangements have not been completed yet.
