

## DEATH OF MR. THOS. SPENCER.

He Passes Away This Morning at His Home on Nelson Street.

Mr. Thomas Spencer, who for many years was stenographer and clerk for Messrs. Hillyer & Bro., died this morning at 10 o'clock, at his residence on Nelson street.

Mr. Spencer was a native of Lancashire, England, but has spent a greater part of his life in America, and at his death was about seventy-four years old.
