Newspaper Laws.

We would call the special attention of our postmasters and subscribers of this paper to the following synopsis of the newspaper laws:

1. A postmaster is required to give notice by letter (returning a papes does not answer the law) when a subscriber does not take his paper out of the office, and state the reasons for not being taken; any neglect to do so makes the postmaster responsible to the publisher for the payment.

ble to the publisher for the payment.

2. Any person who takes a per from the post-office, whether directed to his name or another or whether he has subscribed or not, is responsible for the pay.

3. If any person has ordered his paper discontinued, he must appar discontinued, he must apparent is made, and collect the whole amount, whether it be taken from the office or not. There can be no legal discontinuance until the payment is made, 4. If the subscriber is made, 4. If the subscriber is bound to pay for it, it he takes it out of the postoffice. The law proceeds upon the ground that a man must pay for what he uses.

5. The courts have decided that refusing to take a newspaper or periodical from the postoffice. The law proceeds upon the ground having them uncalled for, is prima facie evidence of intentional frand. **
