To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That in Pursuance of the Act for opening the Land Office, and by virtue of the
Power in me reposed, I HAVE, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Honorable the
Executive Council, given and granted, and by these Presents, in the Name and Behalf of the
said State, DO give and grant unto George Washington, his
Heirs and Assigns forever, All that Tract or Parcel of Land, containing Five
Acres more or less, in the said State, and bearing in the County
of Camden in the said State, and bearing and bounding West
by Major James Oglethorpe's land, both
by George's land, and on the
other sides by vacant land

having such Slaves, Feme, and Marks as appear by a Plat of the same heretofore annexed;
together with all and singular the Rights, Members, and appurtenances thereto, whatsoever, in
the said Tract or Parcel of Land belonging, or in any way appertaining; and also all the Pleas,
Rights, Title, Interest, Claim and Demand, of the State aforesaid, of, to, or out of the
same: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land, and all and singular the
Premises aforesaid, with their and every of their Rights, Members, and appurtenances, unto
the said George Washington, his Heirs and Assigns, to
their own proper Use and behoof forever, in Fee-Simple.

GIVEN under my Hand in Council, and the Great Seal of
the said State, this thirty day of August, in the
Year of our Independence, the thirteen
thirty thirteen Day of August, 1788.
