 and after the death of said Margaret

 said property to absolutely vest in

 as follows.

Item Second, I give bequeath and
 devise to my son Green M Taylor
 94 ninety four acres of land of
 lot number 28 Twenty Eight more
 or less situated in the second
 district of said County, and bounded
 as follows, said land lying in the
 north west corner, commencing at
 the mouth of the head below the
 house, thence up said head to
 the Original line, thence running
 the Original line due west to
 the corner of G. A. Adams to four
 rods, thence said Original

branch thence down the branch back to the starting point.

Item, Third: I give bequeath and devise to my son James B Taylor the following property to wit, ninety four 94 acres more or less of lot of land number 28 Twenty eight, situated in the second district of said County and bounded as follows.

Commencing at the mouth of Bear head thence across the big pond up said pond to the cross pond thence up said side of ponds to the Original line.

Item Fourth: I give and bequeath and devise to my son David B Taylor 94 ninety four acres of land more or less lot number 28 Twenty eight situated in the second district of said County bounded as follows, down said big pond to Original line thence due west said Original line to the Original corner at the residence of W F Taylor.

Item Fifth: I give bequeath and devise to my two sons Elisha B Taylor and Leander Taylor 100 One hundred and eighty eight acres more or less to be divided equal between my two sons to Taylor and Leander Taylor said division to run north and south through said land.

five Dollars has been set aside
out of said Estate, then The remain-
der of The said personal and
prishable property to be equally
divided between The heirs at Law
namely to wit: Missouri F Thomas
Mary A Galtman Green M Taylor
Elida P Hull James S Taylor
Margaret M Taylor David W
Leander Taylor and
Burzilla Taylor
