

Record of the last Will of Daniel McEachin Decedent

State of Georgia, In the name of God Amen
Appling County, I Daniel McEachin a Citizen
of said County and being of advanced age but of
sound and disposing mind and memory and
knowing that I must shortly depart this life
deem it right and proper both as regards my
family and myself that I should make a
disposition of the property with which a kind
Providence has blessed me. Therefore I make
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
all others heretofore by me made.

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and Christianlike
manner suitable to the circumstances and
condition in life. My Soul I trust will
return to rest with God who gave it.

Item 2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid by my executrix herein after named
and appointed.

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved son
Wm McEachin the lot of land number
(589) Five Hundred and eighty nine in the
second district of said County. Except a
Hundred acres on the north side of said
lot which belongs to William Moore.
Twenty acres in the north east corner
which belongs to Henry Post Post
Three Hundred acres the same land
the place where am I now residing.
All of my Household and Kitchen
And all of my Stock of horses and
cattle and hogs which I now
and possess and also all my
property including the same.

To my beloved wife to be used as she
may see proper for her support and
maintenance &c and during her nat-
-ural life and what portion if any is
left at her death I desire and direct
it be equally divided between my four
Youngest Children to wit Emma Joanne
Hester and Altes McEachin

421 I give and bequeath to my son
Andrew C McEachin lot of land
number (634) Six Hundred and thirty four
in the second district of said County
Containing (1190) four hundred and ninety
acres Except One Hundred acres in the
South east corner the same being the
property of Henry Smith

422 I give and bequeath to my son Daniel
H. McEachin (120) One Hundred and
twenty acres situated in the South east
corner of lot of land number (493)
Four hundred and ninety three in the
second district of said County

423 I give and bequeath to my son
James A McEachin the west half of lot
of land number (492) four hundred and
ninety two in the second district in
said County containing (245) two hundred
and forty five acres

424 I give and bequeath to my son William
H. McEachin the east half of lot of land
number (492) four hundred and ninety
two in the second district of said
County containing (245) two hundred

Item 8th I desire, and direct that if I have
not sold or should other wise own at my
death lot of land number (469) Four
Hundred and sixty nine containing
(490) Four hundred and ninety acres and
also two Hundred and seventy five acres
more or less in the north East Corner of
lot of land No (1144) Four Hundred and
forty four both the lots in the second
district of said County be sold by my
Executrix herein after named and appointed
at private sale to the best advantage and
that the proceeds of the said as above said
be appropriated to the payment of my just
debts and defraying of the expenses there
= wise provided for in this will and the
remainder if any to be equally
divided between my wife Mary and
my four younger children to wit
Emory Jerome Charles and Allie Mc
as I have heretofore given my
Children to wit Sarah Morris the
McCormick George W. McCachin Eliza
Johnson Margaret Parish John & Mc
Georgia & McCachin, at Nancy
More property than I have left to
between my wife and my four
Children and it is my wife's
desire that they have no further
interest in my estate

Item 9th I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved wife Mary McCormick
Executrix to this my last will and
Signed sealed and published as my last
Testament this 2nd day of September 1880
