disposing mind and memory,
knowing that I must shortly depart
this life deem it proper both as
respect my family and my self,
that I should make a disposition
of the property with which a kind
providence has blessed me

I do therefore make this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking
all others by me heretofore made
First I desire and direct that my
body be buried in a decent and
Christianlike manner, suitable
to my circumstances and condition
in life. My soul I trust shall
return to rest with God who gave
it, as I hope for salvation through
the merits and atonements of the
blessed Lord and savior Jesus
Christ

Secondly I desire and direct that all
my just debts be paid without
delay by my Executor herein after
named and appointed

and bequeath to my good
Elizabeth Tucker (wife of Isaac Tucker)
one sixth of my whole Estate;
to be paid to my non children

Elizabeth Meeker and her's part.

Fourthly I desire the remaining five sixths
of my Estate be Equally divided
between my five Children or Theirs
heirs namely: Martha Peterson (widow)
of Henry Peterson, Sarah Roberts, wife
of Robert Roberts, The heirs of Riley
Turner, Mary Cobb, wife of E. M.
Cobb, and The heirs of Ellen Taylor
deceased, wife of Mahan Taylor

Fifthly I hereby constitute and appoint
my friend John S. Medders Executor
of this my last will and
Testament.
