do make Publish and declare this to be
my last Will and Testament hereby revoc-
ing and making void all other last Wills
and Testaments which I may at any time
have made and

Item 1st I desire that after my death

My body be decently buried in the
ground and my soul I pray the good God
to take and keep unto himself in Heaven

Item 2nd after the payment of all my just debts

should be so unfortunate as to owe
Person. I give and bequeath unto Mary
E. Heardon my beloved niece all my
Personal property except one bed and
bed furniture which belonged to my
Sister Polly Carter that I bequeath unto
my brother Jesse Carter the personal
property herein before bequeathed unto
Mary E. Heardon Consists of all my
stock of Cattle marked with a
Swallowfork in the left ear and
hole in the right Branded
a (C) also all my stock of Horses
having the same mark that
used on the cattle also all
Corn potatoes and provisions
any kind whatsoever
I may have and
