

Will of Instance Hall Sr Recorded July 6<sup>th</sup> 1885

Georgia In the name of God Amen  
Applying County I Instance Hall Sr of the County  
and State aforesaid being of advanced age but  
of sound and disposing mind and memory  
knowing that I must shortly depart this life  
deem it right and proper both in regards  
to my family and myself to make a bequest  
of the property which a kind providence  
has blessed me

First I devise and direct that my body be  
buried in a decent and Christian like manner  
suitable to my Circumstances and Condition  
in life my Soul I trust shall return to God  
who give it

Second I devise and direct that all my just  
debts be paid without delay by my Executors  
herein after named and appointed

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved  
Wife Mary C. Hall and all of her  
children she now has or may here after have  
by me all of my real and personal property  
that I may die seized and possessed of  
Lot of land number two hundred & six  
(273) and (303) three hundred and three  
the second district of said County. and  
Gray horse and One Rone filley and  
Stock of Cattle Hogs and Sheep more  
square in one sale and under square  
other all my household goods and furniture  
and all and every other species of property  
of all kind I then may possess or  
possessed of by my family divide  
my above named property
