State of Georgia I, Jesse Aldridge of said State
Appling County and County being of advanced
age but of sound and disposing mind and memory
do make this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all others heretofore by me made.
My soul I Trust will return to rest with God
who gave it. Item first I devise and direct
that my body be buried in a decent and
Christian like manner suitable to my Circum-
stances and Condition in life

Item second I give and bequeath and devise
to my wife Mary A. Aldridge twenty five
dollars in Cash to be paid her by my executor
herein after named and appointed with
out termination whatever this amount
is to be paid my wife in lieu of dower and
your support as I do not want her to have
any more of my estate then twenty five
dollars. (Item third) I give and devise
to my sons Mitchell Aldridge and Mauney
Aldridge and Emma Jane Aldridge fifty dollars
each to be paid by my executor out of
my estate. (Item 4) I give and devise to
Barber my step daughter fifty dollars
in Cash to be paid by my executor.

Item 5th I give and devise to John R. Bull
and Isaac Bull and the two younger
of Patience Bull and fifty dollars each to be
paid to them by my executor. Item 6th I give
and bequeath to the said Isaac Bull and
