 bounded as follows on East by  
 Comas Street West by main Street  
 North by Washington Street and  
 South by lands of J. H. Hall for  
 life then to, I do in and become  
 the Proxy of the children of the  
 said Mary Comas and the  
 Grand son of said Mary Comas  
 J. H. Hall and in the event of the  
 death of any of said children  
 on ground above then there issue  
 any to take the place of said  
 deceased except his son  
 Joseph H. Comas who is living  
 It shall be from participation  
 such distribution

I give bequeath and devise  
 to Joseph H. Comas five  
 in case of a dispute
