State of Georgia I Samantha Prescott of the State and
Appling County County aforesaid being of sound and
disposing mind, and Memory do make this my
last Will and Testament.

Item first I give bequeath
and devise My Soul to God Who gave it.

Item second I give bequeath and devise My
body to the Mother earth from whence it came.

Item third I give bequeath and devise to my
Daughter Nancy Prescott all My property

both realty and personally and which I
may die possessed of, including all debts

due me and all money or Chosen in action
which I may die possessed of after paying

all my just debts. Except five Dollars which
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary

Wife of Andrew Wood of said State and County
which five Dollars my said Executor shall

have the right to pay out of any of my property
which she may see fit to pay the sum of

five Dollars is paid within
one year after my death. Item fourth

I desire that the title to the property
I have given bequeath and devised to my

Daughter Nancy Prescott be conveyed
to her by deed and in fee simple in her own

name and assigns at my death.
Item fifth I hereby bequeath and devise

to my Daughter Nancy Prescott all
of this my last will and testament

this the 26 day of February 1884.
