Henry lot of land No (399) three hundred and twenty five square lying and being in the (6) North District of the county of Early and state of Georgia said lot containing (250) two hundred and fifty acres more or less. I also give to my said son W. H. Henry all notes and accounts held against him. I give unto my daughter, Virginia Elizabeth Henry the east half of lot of land No (338) three hundred and thirty eight square lying and being in the 7th Dist of Baker Co. Ga. and known as the Shepherd Lot (containing (125) one hundred and twenty five acres more or less. I also give to my said daughter A. E. Henry (125) one hundred and fifteen acres being a part of lot of land No (305) three hundred and five situated lying and being in the 7th Dist of Baker Co. & state of Georgia. I also give to my said daughter A. E. improvements situated in the lot

also fractional lots (880) Three hundred and eighty and (881) Three hundred and eighty one, all the above named Lots of Lands and fractional lots one situated and lie in the 1st District of Baker County and State of Georgia the following stipulations and conditions in the above named will to my son E. E. Carey is agreed that he to say, I am to receive a home and support for my self during my natural life and also a support and a home for my two daughters Allrian E. Carey and Mary R. E. Carey so long as they remain single or may desire to live with my son E. E. Carey all of the above enumerated lands and properties having been in the peaceable and lawful possession of Robert E. Dorsey, Decd. for deceased and his lawful heirs for the last (30) thirty years to wit (40) years as evidenced by legal titles to same and all lawful taxes having been paid the same having been turned over to me as evidence by agreement hereto attached of all the heirs above named I devise and bequeath to each and every heir as named above the portions allotted to each to have and to hold said premises and properties to the said children as named above their heirs and assigns forever in fee simple and the said Anne Carey testator for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said children and heirs and with their heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid premises that they are free from incumbrances that I have good right to devise bequeath and convey the same to the said children and heirs and their heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said children and their heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and

demands of all persons in witness where
