after payment of my just debts, and
after payment of twenty five dollars
to my husband John B Kidd, and after
payment of twenty five dollars to my
son George F and Kidd, (25,) and after
payment of twenty five dollars (25,) to
Samuel Kidd as set forth in items
3 of this will.

Item 5 I hereby constitute and appoint my son
Willie F Kidd executor of this my last
will and Testament, and I expressly confer
upon him power as such to administer
my estate exonerating him from giving
any Bond or making any inventory and
appraisment or making any returns to
the Orphans.
