

Georgia Baker Cemetery

I now call over by these presents the documents of Galloway of the State and County aforesaid bearing my name and memory and manifest of the uncertainty of life and of the probability of giving directions as to the disposition after my death of the worldly goods with which God in his bounty has blessed me do out this the 28th day of January 1870 make publish and execute this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills made by me at any time.

Item 1st I wish my body to receive a decent Christian burial.

Item 2nd As soon after my death as practicable I will my executors to pay all my just debts including funeral expenses out of any funds on hand.

Item 3rd I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Mrs F. Galloway and to my minor daughter Nellie M. Galloway jointly the following described property to wit one house and lot in the Town of Camilla Mitchell County Georgia known and described as follows four and one half, 4 1/2, acres off of lot of land No three hundred and ninety seven, 397, in the tenth, 10th, Dist. of Mitchell County known as the lot on which Miss Sallie Bunn now resides and also lots of land No eight, 8, Block D and lot No four, 4, lying and being in the said Town of Camilla Also the tract or parcel of land whereon I now reside known and described as twenty five acres off of the south east corner of the South Half of lot of land No Four hundred and four, 404, in the eighth, 8th, Dist. of originally Early now Baker County, together with the store room stock of all kinds including Horse Buggy House hold and kitchen furniture and tools and implements on said place.

Item 4th I will and bequeath to my minor Daughter Nellie M. Galloway all cash on hand after payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses also all notes on hand approximating an amount the sum of five thousand (\$5000⁰⁰) dollars also two bales of Cotton now in store at Albany for special requests given to said notes.

This and the proceedings therein, 3, items is given in order
that they may be made equal to my two older children George
Terry Salloway & I. Salloway as I have heretofore given them
property approximating in value that and set apart to
my Wife and Daughter in these items.

Item 5th I will and bequeath to the children of Wiley L.
Salloway deceased (My Anna Ida Thignt and
Wiley L. Jr. a certain tract or parcel of land known
and described as sixty-two and one half (62 1/2) acres
off of lot of land to three hundred and twenty six (326)
in the eleventh District of Mitchell County Georgia
Item 6th It is my wish that the residue of my property
whether real or personal wheresoever situated be
disposed of as follows to this to be divided into four
equal shares of which one is to go to my wife
Mary H. Salloway one to my Daughter Willie M.
Salloway one to my son George T. Salloway and
one to the children of Wiley L. Salloway Viz
Anna Ida Thignt and Wiley L Jr.

Item 7th It is my wish that in the event of the death of my
wife that my Daughter Willie M shall inherit her
portion of the Estate and in the event of the death of
my daughter Willie M without children then my
wife is to inherit her portion and in the event of the death
of both without children then my son George T. is
to inherit their portion and if he is not living
then his children and if there none living then the
children of I. Salloway shall inherit the same.

Item 8th I hereby nominate and appoint my Friend
Reuben Jones as Trustee or Testamentary Guardian
for my minor Daughter Willie M and authorize &
empower him to take possession immediately after
my death of the money notes and cotton miller by
item of such of this instrument to him individually and
it is my wish that the same is not to go into the hands
of my Executor nor shall he the Executor be required
to give bond for the same but the aforesaid Reuben
Jones Trustee shall give bond and security for the
same and for the faithful performance of his
duties as trustee or Testamentary Guardian as is
required by law in this State and that he proceed
to convert said notes and cotton into cash and to
invest the same in stocks or bonds and to man-

the interest or income thereof or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the expenses of raising and educating his Willie Mo. He shall make regular annual returns to the Ordinary of his acts and doings as required by law and when the said Willie Mo. arrives at the age of twenty one or more shall make a full and final settlement with her.

Item 9th I hereby nominate and appoint my son George G. Gallaway as Trustee or Testamentary Guardian for the children of Riley G. Gallaway who is to receive whatever portion of my Estate they may be entitled to under the provisions of this instrument from the hands of my Executor and to accept him for the same and he shall have the right to use principal and interest in raising and educating the said children he shall also be required to give bond and to make returns as provided in item 8th of this instrument in the case of Reuben Jones Trustee as aforesaid and as provided by law in this state.

Item 10th I hereby nominate & appoint my son George G. Gallaway as my executor to G. G. Gallaway Esq signe sealed and delivered in the presence of F. A. Metts J. H. Caskie
