I Dennis Williams of said State and county being of sound disposing mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament thereby revoking all others 1st I desire that my body be buried in a decent manner by the executor hereinafter named

and I appoint James Baker executor of this will and Testament and he and no one else is to act as sole executor and he is not to give any bond to any one or to make any returns to any one or to any court

3rd I give and bequeath to James Baker all of my property whatever notes and choses in kind I may own at the time of my death or be possessed of at the time of my death

4th I have already deeded to him the land I own and I hereby confirm said deed by giving to him all of my land that I now own or may hereafter acquire

5th said James Baker the executor herein named is authorized to sell any or all of the property that I may be seized and possessed of without any order from any court or from any one else this July 27th 1864
