in a state of separation. This will and
testament to be void and null if said
wife Willford Weatherly and I hereinafter
continue to live together in a state of marriage
as man and wife of which said property both
real and personal of all kind and value to
said I have named wife and child
as beneficiaries that is to say if we hereinafter
are reunited as man and wife and living
as such a man and woman as before.

4. That said child Mildred Weatherly shall
receive my part of said Geo. C. Weatherly's
estate to his death that is to say said child
to receive the same consideration and value
of the estate of said Geo. C. Weatherly as
if would receive should I receive it my
after Geo. C. Weatherly's death.
5. I say said Geo. C. Weatherly he and not
his executor or child at my death
until she

and in case of the death of said Geo E
 Weatherly next to be named is guardian
 of said child - shall be V Weatherly
 in brother.

 family by guardian whenever
