desirous to settle my worldly affairs While I
am the Strongest so to do so make and
publish this my last Will and Testament
after looking all wills by me at any time
made - made And first I commit my soul
to the God who gave it and my body to
be buried in Baker County and my worldly Estate
to be disposed of as follows

First and next that all my just debts be
paid with my own funds

I give and bequeath to my Wife Eliza George
All my real Estate & areas & Land to wit Lot
No 30 in the 1st Sec. 34 1st Dist. 1st
1/2 Sec 1 and South 1/2 Sec 47 all in the
County of Baker State of Georgia and County
above mentioned and the South 1/2 Sec 47 is
situated my residence and all my out
standing debts and the proceeds of the
Cattle, Hogs and Sheep to be kept on the place
for as long as we and kept to raise and
educate and to furnish to the proper wants
of the two minor children Sarah & Eliza
B. and Sarah & George till to be supported
from the proceeds of the plantation and
Stock also the wagon Cart, Farming
Tools House hold and Kitchen Furniture and
fact all perishable property all the above property
mentioned is to be kept together during my
Wife Eliza George Natural life and at her
death to be equally divided among my five
children hereafter named provided the two
males are unmarried & of age if
not I direct my son J. E. George to be and
act as executor in and to the will and the
said James George

3rd I also will and bequeath to my son Joseph E. George the North half (1/2) of Lot Land No 37 in the South (14th) District of the State and County above named.

4th I have also made to my son John B. George a deed to lot of land No 16 in the (17th) District of the State and County above named.

5th I also will and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah E. George lot of land No 45 North half (1/2) lot No 44 in the South (15th) District of the State and County ^{above} named.

6th I also will and bequeath to my son Byron B. George lot land No 86 in the South (17th) District of the State and County above named.

7th I also will and bequeath to my Daughter Laura E. George North half (1/2) of Lot Land No 34 North half (1/2) lot land No 47 in the South (17th) District of the State and County above named.

8th I constitute and appoint my wife Eliza George the executrix of this my last will and Testament.

9th And I direct that my wife the above named executrix be not required to give Bond and Security for her fidelity as executrix of my Estate.
