and it be kept up for their support and  
also the support of my wife & Sister Eliza  
Strongfield during their natural lives and  
after the death of my wife Rachel & Sister  
to our three children above named all the  
property belonging to us which is to be  
equally divided between them the three children  
above mentioned by supporting my Sister Eliza  
during her natural life

4<sup>th</sup> I constitute and appoint my beloved  
wife Rachel Executrix to this my last will  
and Testament

this 4<sup>th</sup> of December 1883
