my last will and Testament hereby revoking
all others heretofore by me made

Item 1, I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent and christianlike manner
suitable to my circumstances and condition
in life

Item 2, I desire that all my just debts be paid
without unnecessary delay

Item 3, I give bequeath and devise to Miss Carolyn
Norm is all my real estate and personal
property including money and notes of which
I ~~may~~ be possessed at the time of my
death and the real estate which I hereby
give and bequeath to her is described
as follows said parcel of Land containing
one acre more or less and being off
Lot of land number 74 one hundred
and seventy two in the eighth District
of Baker County Georgia and being
located in the city of Newton and being
bounded on the North by lands of Colonel
Robert B. Church on the east by lands
of Mrs S. S. Sells on the west by street
or road and on the south by lands of
Newton School three rods and being
lands whereon I now reside

Item 4, I hereby appoint and constitute Miss
Carolyn Norm as my sole executor of this
my last will and Testament and I ex-
pressly confer upon her as such full and
complete power to administer my estate
excusing her from giving any bond or
making any returns to any court whatever
I further confer upon her power as such
executor to sell any portions and the entire
estate without securing an order from
any court so to do and she may do this
either at public or private sale or in
