first it is my desire that all debts that I may
 owe at the time of my death be paid as
 early as possible after my death by my
 executor

second I hereby give grant and bequeath to my
 beloved husband N B Hay the following
 real estate situated in the seventh district
 of Baker county Georgia to wit Ninety
 four acres of land in lot of land number
 ninety three in said district and county
 and being all of said lot number ninety
 three except seventy three acres on the
 North of said lot sold to Alena Hay and
 eighty three acres on the south side of
 said lot sold to Charley Hay said
 tract of Ninety four acres extending
 entirely across said lot of land number
 ninety three from east to west also
 the east half of lot of land number one
 hundred and eight containing one
 hundred and twenty five acres more
 or less except forty two acres more or
 less already deeded to Charley Hay on
 the south side of said half lot and two
 and one half acres more or less in the north
 east corner of said half lot already deeded
 to Alena Hay the number of acres in
 that tract desired being eighty acres more or less
 I hereby give and bequeath to said N B
 Hay any and all other property, both real and
 personal that I may be possessed of at the time
 of my death, including all stock and
 as horses mules, wagons buggies and
 all other property of every nature

that I may own at the time of my death
in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this the fourth day
