and disposing mind and memory do make
1st This my last will and Testament hereby revoking
any and all others that I have heretofore made.

It is my will and desire that my body be
buried in a christian like manner the place
and details of which I leave to my daughter
Hester Williams

and It is my will and desire that all of my
just debts be paid as soon as practicable
after my death

2nd I will bequeath and devise all of my property
both real and personal of whatever nature
and kind to and wherever situated to my
four children namely Lucius Thomas
Lester Thomas Foid Thomas Hester Williams
to be theirs in fee simple forever share
and share a like

4th I hereby make my son Lucius Thomas executor
of this will. and I relieve him from making
any inventory of my property or appraisement
or from giving any bond and he is further
relieved from making any returns of his acts
and doings to any court whatever.
