Know all men by these presents
That I Pung L Omm of this State and County
aforesaid, being of sound and disposing
mind and memory, and mindful of ending
matters while yet in life for the disposition
after my death of this world's goods and effects
with which God has blessed me, do make
publish and declare this my last will and
testament.

Item 1st I wish my Executor hereinafter named, as
soon as possible after my death to pay all
my just debts out of my life Insurance
Money, and to have grave stones erected
over the graves of my wife, daughter and
myself out of the same mentioned funds.

Item 2nd I give to my sister Mary L Omm of Baker
County Ga the sum of \$500 ² Five Hun-
dred Dollars of my life Insurance Money
and which is to be paid to her by my Executor
as soon as the funds are collected, and
to be used by her as long as her need for
disposal, but should there be any balance
of it left after her death and after the pay-
ment of her debts and necessary expenses
the same shall revert to my son William Earl
Omm

Item 3rd I give to my minor son William Earl Omm
all my real and personal estate, lots of land
in the 8th Dist of Baker County viz lots
219-220 and 236 - in the 7th Dist of Baker
County lot No. 248, and $\frac{1}{8}$ interest in lot No
184 together with one dwelling house and
lot and one stone house and lot in
Town of Newnan Baker County and I also give
to my son William Earl Omm all the
remainder of my life insurance money as
mentioned in item 1st and item 2nd and
should my son William Earl Omm die
leaving no child or children as his
heir or heirs all the above mentioned
property or estate shall go to my sister
