Item 3

I give and bequeath and devise to my three children R M Rhodes Jr - Rhodes and Lenora Edwards and to my grandchildren Lucian Edwards and, St. Vincent and to my deceased son, Mrs Sarah Edwards all of my property both real and personal that is to say my three children above named are to take share and share alike and my two grandchildren are to take the undivided one fourth interest of their mother

Item 4

I make ~~make~~ provision for my son Richard Rhodes for the reason that I have heretofore given to his children a tract or parcel of land amounting to fully as much as I now bequeath my other children

Item 5

I hereby constitute and appoint my son T J Rhodes the sole executor of this my last will and Testament and I hereby expressly confer upon him full power as such to administer my estate, excusing him from giving any bond or making any returns to the Ordinary and I expressly confer upon him the full power and authority to sell any part or the entire estate

without any order of court making
good and sufficient conveyance
to the purchaser or purchasers this
