I will give bequeath and devise to my brother Robert Lee Hall all of my property both real and personal of whatever kind and wherever situated to be his absolutely and in fee simple forever

Item 4th

I hereby constitute and appoint my brother R. L. Hall the sole executor of this my last will and testament and relieve him from making any inventory of my property or appraisement or from giving any bond and he is required only by this will to probate the will and I further relieve him from making any returns of his said acts and doings to any court whatever this the twenty-eighth day of March 1919
