Baker County of Williams of said County & State being
of sound mind & of legal age and disposing
Mind & Memory knowing that I must shortly
depart this life I do hereby declare & dispose of the
100 respects my family and myself that
I should make a disposition of the property
with which a kind Providence has blessed
me I do therefore make this my last
Will & Testament hereby revoking all others
heretofore made by me

First I desire & direct that my body be buried in a
decent & Christian like manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life my soul
I trust shall return to rest with God who give
me I hope for salvation through the merits
and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ

Secondly I desire & direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executors here
after named and appointed

Thirdly I desire & direct that my Executors immedi-
ately after my death pay in money Cash
from my Estate the Sum of Two Thousand
Dollars to my daughter Eliza Hender-
Williams the sum of Two Thousand Dollars
Cash to my Son James H. Williams the
Sum of Two Thousand Dollars Cash to my
Son Wm M. Williams the Sum of Two
Thousand Dollars Cash to my daughter
the said Eliza Rebecca Williams the Sum
of Two Thousand Dollars Cash to my
daughter Fanny Ann generally Williams
but not Haniel that is I desire & direct
my said Fanny Ann to be paid to her
husband George C. Russell when
I shall appoint constitute her Executor
I desire that the sum of Two Thousand
Dollars be paid to the said Fanny Ann
hereafter appointed for my daughter
Mary Susan Williams said sum
of money to be distributed by her

In said Guardian in some valuable books
for safe keeping as such the said
said Book is willing to pay until my
said daughter Mary Susan arrives at the
age of Eighteen years at which time I
direct that said money by her said Guardian
or paid to her for her own proper use &
benefit and said Guardianship to cease
from that day. I desire that the sum of
Ten Thousand dollars in cash be paid to the
Guardian of my daughter Lula Hemmick
thereafter appointed to be controlled by the said
Guardian to the best interest of the said
Lula & until she arrives at the age of Eighteen
years at which time I desire that the said
said Guardian pay in to her said amount
of money for her own proper use & benefit
and said Guardianship to cease from
that day. I desire the sum of Ten Thousand
dollars in cash be paid to the Guardian
hereafter appointed for my daughter Lula
Roe to be controlled and managed by said
Guardian to the best interest of my said
daughter Lula Roe until she arrives
at the age of Eighteen years at which time
I direct that said Guardianship pay in to her
said sum of money for her own proper
use and benefit and said Guardianship
to cease from that day.

Fourthly I desire and direct that all my notes &
accounts mortgages liens and claims in
nature of any description whatsoever be
gathered together by my Executors and
converted into cash as early as possible
and when the same is collected or
is much thereof as can be to be equal-
ly divided between all my children
and also so much of my indebtedness
as has been proper to be paid by my
Executors.

Fifthly I desire and direct that my trustees

Youngest Children have a good Country School
English Education and that my Executors
make ample provision out of the residue of
my Estate to carry out this desire & give
it effect

Sixthly I desire and direct that my real Estate consisting
of Land & Tenements be kept together by my
Executors and, used to the best interest of
my said Children the proceeds thereof to
be equally divided between them all until
my Youngest Child Lulu H. and Lila
R. Harris at the age of Eighteen years
or until our said Youngest Child being
of the age of Twenty (one year shall demand)
a demand of my said property in either
event I desire my Executors to select and
appoint four discreet & proper men to appraise
said my said real Estate into a number
of shares equal to the number of my said
Children and that a plot of such four
shares by my Executors shall be made and
signed to contain the number of the lots
of land in each and the number of acres
within the County & District where situated
together with a full description of said
property I then desire my Executors to
place said things in a numbered
cabinet in a box provided by them for
that purpose and that each of my
said Children or their Guardians and
heirs, or any one of them or share
by each Child or Guardian of each
Child the said property, together
described in said share to give &
signify to said Child with all the rights
and interests and opportunities therein
in my said property and belongings

Seventhly I desire for the education of my two
Youngest Children Lulu H. and Lila R.
to be made in the Fifth year
of this will I desire that to be done

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against them the same being an ~~open~~
provision out of that portion of my estate
described in said clause for their benefit

Eighth) The Residue from property whatever and
right may be I desire Equally divided
between all of my children

Ninth) I hereby appoint and constitute J H Williams
and W W Williams Guardians for my minor
daughter Mary Susan for the
length of time and upon the terms and conditions
set forth in the third clause of this will

Tenth) I hereby appoint and constitute J H Williams
and W W Williams Guardians for my minor
child Lela Henrietta for the length of time
and upon the terms and conditions set forth
in the third clause of this will

Eleventh) I hereby appoint and constitute J H Williams
and W W Williams Guardians for my minor
child Lela Hop upon the terms and conditions
and for the length of time set forth in the third
clause of this will

Twelfth) I hereby appoint and constitute my son David
James H Williams and William W Williams
executors of my last Will & Testament
this June 17th 1872
