

Georgia Cass County July 16th 1842

My last will and Testament, made of my own will and accord,
being sound in Body and mind.

1st After all my just debts are paid, I want my beloved daughter
Cynthia Adaline, to have a Negro boy Green, to be valued and if
the valuation does not amount to 550 dollars, for that amount to
be made up to her in money or other property such as she wants.
(2nd) I want my beloved son Samuel I. Chandler to have a
Negro boy Levi to be valued when said Samuel arrives to the
age of Eighteen years old and if the said Levi is not valued to
six hundred dollars, then that amount to be made up to him
in money or other property such as he wishes to have also a little land.

3rd. I want my beloved daughter Amelia, Susanna, Chandler to have a negro girl Jane, when married, or at the age of seventeen years old to be valued, and if not valued to five hundred and fifty dollars, for that amount to be made up to him in money or other property, such as she wants.

4th. I want my beloved son Abraham Row Chandler, to have a negro boy Andy to be valued when Abraham Row arrives to the age of Eighteen years old and if said boy Andy is not valued to six hundred dollars, I want that amount to be made up to him in money or property such as he wants also a Rifle Gun extra.

5th. I want my beloved wife Mary M. Chandler to have all the balance of my negroes that I have not given away in this my will during her natural life or widowhood, also this my settlement of land lying in Cass County on Castanalee River if she marries again to have a child's part. I wish her to have the use of said premises and negroes not named in said will, for to raise said children that are now under age also to give them a good English education I also want all the negroes that are not named in said will to remain on said farm till Row comes of age I wish my wife Mary Chandler after my death to keep so much of the household and kitchen furniture and as much of the stock and sell all the balance. It is my wish for my wife Mary Chandler also my son Robert D. Chandler & Daniel Johnson and M. A. Chandler to be Executors to this my last will.

6th. I also wish Erans and Row to have the use of their House and Land till Row comes of age that is the premises that (or so much of the Farm as they can tend) if their mother dies before they are of age for them to have so much of the Land as they can tend till they are of age
