at the discretion of my Executor nothing doubting but as
general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
Almighty Power of God and as touching such worldly
Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life

I give demise and dispose of in the following manner and form
First I want all my just debts and burial expences to be paid.
Then I want Isaac my Sister to have five dollars and no more. Then
I want my Sister Sam Gillispie to have ten dollars. Then I want my
Sister Margant to have my cow. Then all other property both real
and personal to be sold on a twelve months credit to the highest
bidder and the money when collected together with money I
have on hand to be equally divide betwixt my and Rachael
Matilda, Mary Hannah, Margant Bow, Ann, Doreus Bird, Sarah
Synfield, Elizabeth Cowser, Nancy Malinda.

I also do likewise constitute make and ordain Jonathan H White
my Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament.

And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disonment all and
every other former Testaments, wills, Legacies, bequests, and Executors
by me in any wise before made made will, and bequeathes ratifying
and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
twenty sixth day of April one thousand Eight hundred and
thirty Eight.
