and considering the uncertainty of this mortal life
do make or give publick and declare this my last
will & Testament in manner and form following to wit
First It is my will and desire that all my just
debts be paid and that my body be committed to
the earth in decent burial. ~~Item~~
Now Having already given and delivered to my
son John Bartow and wife Sarah Bartow and to my
daughter Kelly Russell and Anna Gerrell property
to the amount and value of two thousand one
hundred and fifty two and a half dollars each
It is my will and desire that all the rest and
remain of my Estate of which I may die possessed
either personally or real be sold by my Executors
hereinafter named the debts accounts rights
and credits collected and out of the proceeds thereof
that my said Executors shall pay one to my
grand children the heirs and children of my
daughter Elizabeth of Betsey McDonald and

the infant Son of my deceased Mary Ann Parker To be considered as entitled to one
Share and to stand in the place of its deceased
Mother the Sum of Two thousand five hundred
and fifty two and a half Dollars Share and share
alike to be paid them when they arrive at their
respective Ages of Twenty one years or more.
Item It is further my Will and desire that all the
Net and residue of my Estate be divided equally
Among my two said Son my said daughter and
their heirs and legal representations being
four shares and that the said Children of
said deceased daughter Betsey McDonald
including the Infant Son of the said Mary Ann Parker
deceased as aforesaid and the survivors and
survivors of them and their legal representations
being together one other share
Item It is further my Will and desire that if
my said great Grand Son the Son of my
deceased Grand daughter Mary Ann Parker
should die under the age of twenty one years
without Child or Children him surviving that
then and in that case his part or share of my
said Estate is to go to and be equally divided
Among the Children of my said deceased
daughter Betsey McDonald and the survivors
or survivors of them and their legal representations
Item It is further my Will and desire that whatever
I may hereafter during my life give or pay
or whatever I may have heretofore given
or paid to any of my said Sons (except
as hereintofore excepted) shall be taken and
considered as part of his her or their share of my
said Estate unless otherwise expressed in the receipt
or receipts I may take for the same so that
effectually all my said Sons & daughters
shall share equally in my said Estate the Children
of my deceased daughter Betsey McDonald
to have an equal share as aforesaid
Item It is further my Will and desire that
in as much as a young boy named Bill
which I gave my said Son Parker

nothing in his said named estate nor the value
of the said negro boy, but he is not to be bound
against my said son Cyprian Basser in any future
division of my said property or estate
Item I further my Will and desire that after my
death my wife Woman shall be under
the control of my son Cyprian Basser but not to be
sold as any part of my said estate and that
he shall not be accountable either for her value or
vice

Item I do hereby nominate and appoint my two
sons Joel Basser and Cyprian Basser Executors
of the my last Will and testament
