

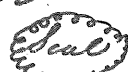
Georgia In the name of God Amen:

respects myself and my family that I should make
a disposition of the property which a kind Providence
has blessed me, I therefore make this my last Will
and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all
others heretofore made by me.

Item first I give and direct that my Body be
Buried in a decent and Christian-like manner
suitable to my Condition and Circumstances, My
Soul I Trust shall Return to rest with God who
gave it as I hope for Eternal Salvation through
the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ in
whose religion I hope.

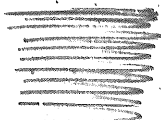
Item Second I Give and direct that all my
Just debts be paid without delay by my Executors
herein after named as I am unwilling my Creditors
should be delayed of their rights especially as
there is no necessity for delay.

Item Third I Give and direct to my beloved wife
Jane and her two last children they being lawful
children of mine, all my Estate both Real &
Personal whomever and whatever it may be.

Item fourth I constitute and appoint my
Father Elijah Pinson and my worthy friend
Newport Floyce Executors to this my last Will
and Testament; this 31st day of October 1850
