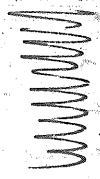

namely Negroes to wit Peter an old man and his
Wife Levin, Anthony a Boy, Stephen a boy and
Cecy a girl, together with Store of all kind suffi-
cient for her use, with a sufficient quantity of home
hold and Kitchen Furniture to make her comfort-
able and it is my wish & desire that my Executors
Should purchase out of the proceeds of the Sale of
my real Estate a Lot or tract of Land for the use
of my wife Elizabeth during her natural life
all of which said property at the death of my said
Wife Should revert to and become a part of my
Estate and become subject to like distribution at the
next.

3rd Third I give my will to

Shewen I do Let or tract of Land number one hundred and forty five in fifteen the District 3rd time Section now Chap County known as the Waiter Place when ever they Can do so advantageously, and to apply the proceeds of the same to the use and benefit of my daughter Louisa Hilburn wife of Robert F. Hilburn and as the lawful heir of her body, I further now appoint my Exors Wm H Bailey and David Morrow trustees under the bequest of my Will to Carry the same into effect Confering on them discretionary power to Carry out this part of my Will together with the balance that will be coming to my daughter and her heirs in the division of my said Estate, and that the said trustees have power to apply such part of the proceeds of the sale of the Land to the use & support of my daughter and her heirs that in their judgement she stands in need of from time to time, and in Case Robert F. Hilburn should die before my daughter, then it is my wish for my Executors or trustees, to pay over to my daughter Louisa Hilburn & her heirs their legal portion of the Estate in their hands.

4th Fourth It is my will and desire that all the balance of my Estate both real and personal not herein enumerated should be sold by my Executors and to be equally divided amongst my Children, viz Mary Anne Bailey Sarah H Garamer wife of Hilory S Garamer Nancy M Walker wife of the late Samuel Walker deceased, Asariah P Bailey, Martha B Bailey Mary H Bailey, Malissa B Bailey & William H Bailey and Louisa Hilburn wife of Robert F. Hilburn through her trustees appointed in this Will, William H Bailey and David Morrow, and that my Executors take the most practicable way of giving to each the amount to which they may be entitled in this Will whenever they may marry or become of age

5th Fifth Having already given to my son William H Bailey & my son Asariah P Bailey to my daughter Sarah H Garamer wife of Hilory S Garamer, my daughter Nancy M Walker wife of the late Samuel Walker deceased the sum each of five hundred Dollars in Cash and one further sum and a fraction.
