 of either event it is my will and desire that the
 property be aforesaid with its accretions

and in case is equally divided the ~~half part~~
of which I do give & bequeath to my Husband as aforesaid
Allen S. Williams and the other moiety or half parts to my
Sons aforesaid Eli or Thomas Moore Perrian Wemyss
to be divided to them & each of them severally their heirs
and assigns in fee simple forever ~~and also charged~~
from all Trust uses Conditions or ^{limitations} what ever
and it is further my will and desire that in the event
of my said Son departing this life before he shall
have attained the age of twenty one or shall have
married that then and in that case my entire prop-
erty as aforesaid shall by not remain in my Husband
Allen S. Williams his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever
him It is my will and desire that my Son Elvir Thomas
Moore Perrian Wemyss be Educated at the best School and
in the best manner that the property as aforesaid will
warrant

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my said
Husband and under Allen S. Williams and Thomas
Moore Perrian Wemyss Executors to this my last said
Will and Testament and it is my wish and desire that
they act as Guardians to my child
