 Lackey of the County and State aforesaid
 do ordain this my last Will and Testament in the name
 and form following; to wit, 1st I give and bequeath to my
 beloved wife Nancy Lackey all my house-hold furniture
 except that part already owned by my Daughter Sarah Lackey
 and Nancy M. McGuire, also all my Stock of cattle
 except two cows which I bequeath to my Daughter Sarah
 Lackey and two cows which I bequeath to my daughter
 Nancy M. McGuire. My Stock of Hogs I give and bequeath
 to my Son Reuben D. Lackey and William S. Lackey
 to hold equally between them and my family to be
 supported out of said Stock so far as pork may be requ-
 ired as long as they may continue to live together.
 I bequeath to my wife Nancy Lackey my man during her
 natural life. I give and bequeath to my Son Robert D.
 Lackey my horse Colt. I give and bequeath to my Son
 William S. Lackey and my Son Reuben D. Lackey all
 my land with all the rights member and appurtenances
 thereto belonging consisting of two lots known as

and lot number nine hundred and twenty both lots
lying in the fourth District of the third Section formerly
Cherokee now DeKalb County containing forty acres each, to be
equally between them. Now I do hereby constitute my Son
Reuben P. Lackey my Executor to carry into effect all of
the foregoing and subsequent provisions of this my said
Will & Testament. Signed with my own proper hand and

survive me) all the property of this property of during her life and
at her death I give & bequeath the Same to my Son David W.
Lewis to him & his heirs forever. I also make constitute & ordain
my Son David W. Lewis my Sole Executor of this my last will
