

Georgia Cass County I Zachariah B. Hargrove have appointed

 my Executors of this my last will and Testament. I have conferred
 to them all the authority which I by law possessed over the Control
 of my own Property. They are authorized to make all contracts
 to execute all instruments in writing in fulfillment thereof which
 the interest of my Estate may seem to require. I wish all my
 debts paid as Speedily as possible and in no court (if practicable
 to avoid it-) to suffer suits to be commenced on any occasion.
 I am owing some debts in some of the Banks of Georgia, to wit in
 the Central Bank of Georgia, Georgia Rail Road Bank, the
 branch of the Danian Bank at Dalton and the Western Bank
 of Georgia, which I wish to see in the several Banks until my
 debts shall have been sufficiently marshalled to discharge the
 debts. I authorize my Executors to sell my Iron and Iron
 property at Rome so soon as it can be brought fairly into market.
 I am the owner of four hundred and ninety eight shares in the
 Western Bank of Georgia and perhaps something over which I
 desire should be sold as soon as it may be convenient
 practicable. I authorize my Executors to sell all the

which I own in the other or the portion of Georgia whenever they may think it prudent to do so. I am instituting a speculation at and near Red Landing in the State of Tennessee in connection with a Mr Samuel Williams and Frank Leaster a memorandum of the terms of which is amongst my papers; my Executors are authorized to dispose of my interest in that operation whenever a neat profit of Ten thousand dollars can be realized, and not for that should they clearly be satisfied that it is worth more. After my Estate shall have been fairly settled and the debts that I am owing discharged and a settlement in all respects made, I desire the residue to be equally divided between my wife Malinda and my children I have and I have alike. When ever either of the Legacies Mary Mary I desire that they may have advance to them the whole or such portion of their Shares as the condition of my Estate will justify.

In addition to the commissions which by Law allow me on those occasions I authorize my Executors to allow to and pay to my Executor such additional sum as he may think his trouble his vigilance and fidelity may be consistent with the principles of Justice for him to receive. I authorize Chester Harolds to make a full and final settlement with James M Spullock my Executor in relation to the Mercantile transactions in which we have recently been engaged in the Town of LaFayette and in no event to permit a difficulty to arise which may lead to litigation.

Having sold to Job Rogers Real Estate to a considerable amount it is my desire that as much indulgence in the payments thereof be extended to him as may be consistent with the interest of my Estate. I have sold some lands for which my Bonds are out for Titles upon the payment thereof. I hereby appoint Malinda Harpore and James M Spullock Guardians for my children whose portions will be advance to them upon arrival at maturity or marriage upon the terms herein jointly and severally. What small portions of perishable property I have my Executors will dispose of in such manner as they may think proper. I do not wish the horses and Carriage sold but to be kept in the family for their use.

My Executors are authorized to purchase a residence for the family where and whenever they may think proper which is to be considered as the property of the Estate but not subject to a charge as long as my Executors may see proper.
