

Georgia, Berrien, County

I, J. C. B. Rabun, being of sound mind and of good health, and desiring to make a disposition of the property and effects that I have accumulated during my life-time, do herein and hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby expressly revoking all others heretofore made by me.

Item 1.

I commit myself, soul, body and mind to God the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, who created, provided for and redeemed us, and in whom we, soul, body and mind have lived and had our being, and from whom we have received every good and perfect gift. To this Triune God we commit us for the remainder of life, in death and to all eternity to do for us and by us as seemeth them good in their infinite mercy, grace and love whereby they have made such an exceeding great, glorious and perfect sacrifice for our present and eternal salvation and for which we in our utter unworthiness for all these great blessings would give all praise, thanksgiving, glory and honor both now and forever.

Item 2.

I desire that all my just debts be paid (if I owe any) as soon as practical after my death by my executor herein-after named, including my burial expenses.

Item 3.

I also desire that the burial expenses of my wife, Adah Kate Samuels be paid out of my estate. Also that a simple slab and head mark be provided for each of our graves including the grave of my first wife (buried at Danville Georgia) of marble.

Item 4.

The remainder of both my personal

property and real estate, also cash (if any) shall be used in the best manner possible in the judgement of my executor of this my will, for the comfort, maintenance and care of my present wife, and in no other way, during the remainder of her natural life, and the remainder at her death to be equally divided between my five (5) children, or their heirs, and H. B. Samuels, the blind brother of my present wife.

Item 5,

In the event I shall survive my wife, then I direct that my said estate shall be divided share and share alike between my said five children and H. B. Samuels, and as above specified. In the event I survive the said H. B. Samuels, then my entire estate shall be equally divided share and share alike between my five children, the division to be made only after the death of my said wife.

Item 6.

I further will and direct that in the event it becomes necessary in the judgement and discretion of my executor, to sell any part of my estate, either for the purpose of maintaining, supporting or taking care of my said wife, or carrying out any of the other provisions of this my last will and testament, that he shall have the right to sell the same, or any part thereof either at public or private sale, in his discretion, without obtaining any order from the Ordinary, and he is hereby given authority to execute a deed or bill of sale to the same without any order from any Court or other authority except this will, and it is my will and desire that my executor be relieved from making any returns to the Court of Ordinary, except a final return which I direct that he make. I direct, however, that he keep

at all times a fully itemized statement or book account of all receipts and disbursements subject to inspection by either of the distributors or interested parties.

Item 7.

I hereby name and appoint Edwin R. Smith, of Nashville, Georgia, executor of this my last will and testament, and direct that my estate be administered as in this will provided in Berrien County, Georgia, regardless of where I may reside, or be domiciled at the time of my decease.
