First.

Second.

That should there be any part of said property here in bequeathed, left over after the death of the survivor, as Contemplated in the first Item of this Will, And in that event said remainder- over shall immediately Vest in and become the property of William Baker and Mrs. Mollie Copeland, Brother and Sister of said Fannie Albritton, in fee Simple, Share and Share alike.

Third.

We here by appoint the survivor of the Undersigned as Executor or Executrix of this our last Will And Testament. Empowering Him or Her, after the Probation of this Will, to have and use said property As His or Her own, Subject to the limitations as Set forth in the first And Second Items hereof.

We relieve the said Executor or Executrix from making Bond, or return, To any Court whatsoever.
