

Georgia, Barren County

I, Mrs. Fannie Peoples Gaskins (One and the same person as
Mrs. A. H. Gaskins), being of sound and disposing mind and memory,
do make, publish, and declare my Last Will and Testament as follows,
hereby expressly revoking any and all other wills heretofore made by
me;

Item 1.

I desire my body buried in a Christianlike manner, in
keeping with my position in life, in the A. H. Gaskins family
lot in the Nashville, Georgia, Cemetery, beside the grave of
my deceased husband A. H. Gaskins, as shall be directed
by my executors hereinafter named in this my Will.

Item 2.

I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Ruby Gaskins
Turner my house and lot and the land going in connection therewith,
known as "The Old Peoples Home and Lot," in the City of
Nashville, Barren County, Georgia, to be hers absolutely in fee simple.

Item 3.

I give and bequeath to my beloved son A. H. Gaskins, Jr.
my storebuilding located on East Marion Street, in which the A. H.
Gaskins Estate Store - Stock is now located, in the City of Nashville,
Barren County, Georgia, to be his absolutely in fee simple.

Item 4.

I give and bequeath to my son Robert Gaskins my
home and premises in which I now reside, including the
tract across the street which we commonly call the "Gardens"
located in the City of Nashville, Barren County, Georgia, to be
his absolutely in fee simple.

Item 5.

I will and direct that my four children, Ruby Gaskins
Turner, Marie Gaskins Prince, A. H. Gaskins, Jr. and Robert Gaskins,
fix the value of ^{of each} the above properties mentioned in Items 2, 3
and 4 above of this my Will, and that the value of
the other two pieces of said property be equalized with the
value of the piece of said property above bequeathed which
they agree to be of the highest value, by giving to the
two beneficiaries receiving the above pieces of property of the
lesser value cash from my estate to make each valuation
to said three heirs equal in amount. In the event my said
four children cannot agree on the respective values of the
properties bequeathed in said Items 2, 3 and 4 of this my
Will, then said children are to name fair and impartial

Appraisers to Appraise said respective Properties and fix
the value on each of said three bequests, each of my said
Children to name one Appraiser each, and the decision of a
Majority of them so named as Appraisers shall fix the value
of the Property under each of said three bequests.

I Will and direct that, after the value of each bequest
under Items 2, 3 and 4 of this my Will, has been ascertained as
directed in Item 5 above of this my Will, that an amount
in Cash from my estate equal to the highest value ascertained
of said three bequests be delivered to my beloved daughter
Marie Gaskins Prince, and this amount in Cash I Give and
bequeath to her to be hers absolutely and in fee simple.
It being my intention that each of my said four Children
shall receive Property or Cash of equal value each with the
other, under Items 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this my Will, as Special
Bequests.

I Will and direct that my executors hereinafter named
in this my Will, pay all my debts and the expenses of Adminis-
tration from my Personae Property, if there be sufficient for
that purpose; if not, then they are to sell enough of my
realty not above specially bequeathed, and pay my debts
with the proceeds of such sale.

All the rest and residue of my estate of every kind
and character I give to my four children, Ruby Gaskins Turner,
Marie Gaskins Prince, G. W. Gaskins, Jr. and Robert Gaskins Shaw and
share alike, to be theirs absolutely and in fee simple.

Item 8

I appoint my Children, Ruby Gaskins Turner, Marie Gaskins
Prince, G. W. Gaskins, Jr., and Robert Gaskins as the survivors
of them at my death, as the joint Executrix of this my Will;
and I relieve them from making any Appraiser of my estate
as a whole, and from making any inventory thereof, and from
giving any bond.
