 that I should make a disposition of the property

 me. I do therefore make this my last will
 and testament, hereby revoking and annulling
 all others heretofore made by me.

Item 1 I desire and direct that my body
 be buried in a decent and christian like
 manner suitable to my circumstances in
 life. my soul I trust will return to rest
 to God who gave it.

Item 2 I give and bequeath to my son
 William A. Garrett Five hundred and two
 dollars and sixty seven cents the amount
 of money drawn from the United States
 as back pay on my pension also all
 pay that I have received since then the
 same being \$8.50 per month and also
 all future pay, that I may receive to my
 death. I am led to make this disposition
 of my property to the exclusion of my sons
 D. B. Garrett and Joseph C. T. Garrett of the state
 of Texas. also Sophia Stephens wife of
 L. M. Stephens Francis Sutton widow of
 John L. Sutton, Nancy Lapp, Sally Hodge
 also children of America, Faulkner, and
 B. S. Garrett, deceased for the following
 reasons to wit: that my son W. A. Garrett
 has been a kind and dutiful son to me.

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has taken care of me in my old age
supplying me with food and raiment
and I feel that he should receive some
recompense for said service so rendered
to the exclusion of the other offoresaid
heirs, who have contributed but little to
my support.

Item 3. I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved son W. H. Garrett, Executor
of this my last will and testament
This Feb 6th 1883.
