Plan 1 I desire at My death that my body be buried in a decent like manner according to my circumstances in life My soul I commend to God who gave it

Plan 2 I Give and bequeath to My daughter A M Jackson Twenty dollars she hereby has received her portion of my estate.

Plan 3 I Give and bequeath to My sons Robert H & Balus C Hutchinson ten dollars each they hereby received their portion of my estate

Plan 4 I Give and bequeath to My son Henry H Hutchinson One Hundred dollars

Plan 5 I Give and bequeath to My Grand son Robert B. Inceed Twenty five dollars. And hereby insist My executors that the several sums of Money together with my funeral expenses and what just debts I may owe at the time of My death be paid out of the proceeds of My personal Estate I hereby reserve the right to pay any or all the sums of Money above bequeathed to my heirs during My Natural life by receipting me for the same

Plan 6 I hereby Give to My daughter Polly Hutchinson all the residue of my Estate real and personal what includes the place on which I now live the same being the East half of Lot of Land # 390 in the 9 West of Arizona Inceed now Berrien Co

Will of Henry G. Hutchinson An husband
 Remand and forty five Acres More or less
 the said property here bequeathed to my
 daughter Polly is to remain in the
 possession of my beloved wife American
 Hutchinson for her use and benefit
 as long as she remains a widow or
 until my daughter Polly Hutchinson becomes
 of Age to act for herself in the event
 my daughter Polly should die before she does
 At Maturity then the above described property
 given to her is to still remain in the
 possession of my beloved wife American
 Hutchinson until her death or until
 she marries again, In that event the above
 described property is to be equally divided
 between my heirs mentioned in Items 2
 3 4 & 5 of this my last will and tes-
 tament and should my daughter Polly and
 my wife American both die before my
 daughter becomes of Age to act for herself
 then said property to be equally divided
 as above specified

Item 7 I hereby constitute and appoint
 my friends Warner L. Benson Nelson
 Jones & W. H. Sneed Executors of this my
